Preschool Registration

Registration for the 2008-09 school year will begin Monday, February 4, 9:30-11:30. Your child will be bringing home a registration packet this week.

Currently enrolled students will have the first opportunity to register on Monday, February 4. Church members can register on Tuesday, February 5. The general public will register on Wednesday, February 6. Registration will continue until classes reach capacity. A student will be considered registered when a completed registration form is received and a \$75 registration fee is received.

The 2008-09 tuition fees will be \$100 for 2-day classes, \$135 for 3-day classes, \$165 for 5-day, and \$170 for Pre-Kindergarten. The Pre-K will be available to students who have completed a four-year-old class.

Next year AFCP will offer two-day two-year-old classes (Tuesday/Thursday and Wednesday/Friday). The three-year class offerings will be two-day (Tuesday/Thursday) and three-day (Monday-Wednesday-Friday). Our four-year-olds will have the option of three-days (Monday-Wednesday-Friday) and five-days. A five-day Pre-Kindergarten class will be offered again next year. Children must be of specified age for the requested class by October 16, 2008.

We hope that you will consider enrolling at Adams Farm Christian Preschool again next year. Refer another student and receive a \$50 credit towards your first 2008-09 tuition payment.
